(140 lb) They call me the Island Girl in the ring. Christy Martin left the ring with a towel over her head and sunglasses on to cover her swollen face and 2 swollen eyes. She went to the hospital for the first and only time in her professional career. I had only been boxing 2 years. I backed her up for 10 rounds. She never would rematch me and actually lied about me wanting \$1 million in 1999 as to why she wouldn't rematch me. That was ridiculous, but her way of avoiding a rematch.

At that time, her opponent for July 30, Lucia Rijker, was busy chasing and calling Martin out. Martin played the 'duck and dodge' game because she liked being the center of attention and knew Lucia had a good shot at beating her.

I've been calling out Lucia Rijker for years. She was the hunter, and now has become the hunted. I've fought all top notch competition at 140...girls Rijker and Martin avoided like the plague. I was voted P4P best female fighter in the world by Ring magazine. I've had 3 fights in two years which is ridiculous for a fighter. I've literally been challenging and almost begging for fights and last year I was voted most avoided fighter by WBAN. Martin and Rijker are trying to shut me out because they know I CAN BEAT THEM BOTH ON THE SAME NIGHT.

I publicly challenged Lucia Rijker last year, (see attachment) I can send you webpages of my challenges....made last year and published all over the net and personally sent to her too. Pre-Million Dollar Baby I might add. I already beat Martin, and I'm ranked above Rijker in every alphabet. I have 4 world titles, they have none. I can send a webpage of that too. And, if you check out www.boxrec.com, you'll see that I'm ranked #1 there too.

After beating Martin, I never marketed myself so I haven't made a NAME for myself in boxing. I naively thought that as an athlete, all I had to do was be the best and that everything else would be secondary. Well, marketing is everything as an athlete I've learned.

Rijker is avoiding the legitimate person, ME, that she should be fighting. Martin is past her prime and is a much easier target. Neither one of them is the best. Neither one of them have any world titles. What they have is a NAME.

Women's boxing is being choked by the insanity of NAME recognition. It's not based on merit or skill. If either one of them has any professional pride, the winner will fight me. (Well, IF Martin wins, I know a rematch with me will never happen. I beat her up too bad) So, if Rijker wins, if she has any professional pride, she needs to fight me.
